**\*Minimum requirements to apply for State ESG funds are as follow:**

- **City of Oklahoma City and City are Tulsa service providers are not eligible for these funds. Separate funding is available in these communities.**
- **Applicants must be members of their local Continuum of Care Network**
- **Applicant must be participating in HMIS data collection or be prepared to start entering once funds are awarded (with exception of Domestic Violence shelters who must have a comparable system).**
- **100% of grant funds must be matched.**
- **First-time applicants must have a Sponsor to apply.**
